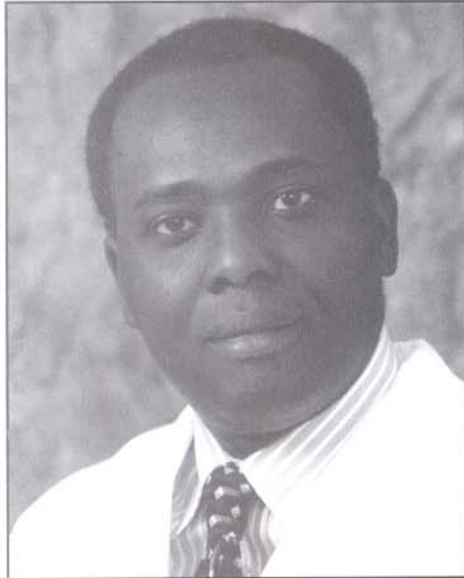


Uchenna R. Nwaneri, M.D.
